Our **SVP Conference** are due meet in the Christian Centre after Mass but will make their own arrangements to fit in with the parish meeting.

**Sunday 14 (and Sunday 21) April 9.00 am** On these two Sunday's straight after Mass the whole parish will meet 'in council' to listen to each other and formulate our parish response to the '**Aylesbury Listening Process – New Wineskins**'. Bishop David has asked the Catholic communities of Aylesbury, Princes Risborough, Wendover, Long Crendon and Haddenham to reflect on our future development. What new wineskins - structures, pastoral provision, activities, buildings - do we need as we look to the next 30 years? Building on the Synod and Assembly processes, there will be listening groups in every church and community. **How will we do this? As soon as Mass finishes on Sunday 14 April please go into the Christian Centre and collect a cup or tea or coffee and then go into St Anne's Hall. Once in St Anne's Hall please collect chairs and arrange yourselves into small groups of roughly no less than 3 and no more than 6. When we are settled Father Derek will explain the task we are to undertake and how our gathering will work. Please note that young people and the smallest children are a vital part of the process and should be given honoured places in our groups – no one can be left out! Please also note that the gathering will last no more than an hour.**

Information about the **Northampton Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes** as part of the Catholic Association Pilgrimage from Friday 23 to Friday 30 August is displayed on the notice board in the church narthex.
